Dear Jean Wiegand, ServAsk:

1. Yes. Our LORGE FOR WISCONSIN U.S. Senate Campaign is all about "BUILDING UP AMERICA". I favor tax cuts to help small businesses grow, as well as cutting red tape, simplifying regulations, since, as you already know, many of the federal regulations amount to mountains of red tape paperwork that suffocates small business especially, as they are not geared up with teams of accountants and lawyers and staff like multi-nationals are, to deal with federal red tape, reporting, and paperwork requirements. In fact, that is why some of that red tape exists (to give big companies an advantage and to disadvantage small businesses from being able to compete for business in the same markets). I will change that, with sunset laws on all regulations, simplifications of all paperwork to equalize the playing field, and cutting taxes, that will keep the pressure on Washington to cut wasteful spending, we give them less so they have less to spend in the first place. I also favor putting 5% across the board agency salary cuts, giving agency heads the ability to fire deadwood and unproductive workers, implement efficiency along with austerity, and if they fail to do so, making costs cuts (not on program benefits but on staff and administration costs) then there will be an automatic 5% salary cut across the board. This will be to introduce productivity gains that private sector businesses have achieved year in and year out (around 4%) which has not been done in federal agencies. I also favor tax credits for health care insurance, unearned tax credit refunds, so that the entire 46 million with no health insurance will get a tax refund check equal to their health care premiums. This will stop socialized medicine (the Kennedy and Hillary Clinton National Health Care Socialized plans) and its evil twin universal single payer 50 state mandatory healthcare plans (a 50 state Socialized medicine plan-The Feingol Socialized medicine plan). Instead of sending more and more tax dollars to Washington to waste on socialized medicine where the government thinks they should decide what kind of health care is best for you, which socialized plans are more expensive and lack quality, instead, under the Lorge Healthcare tax credit refund plan, Washington sends you your money (and never forget it is YOUR money) back to you, and you decide what healthcare insurance plan is best for you yourself, you choose your own doctors and clinics and health insurance company because now you have something they want: The premium money! This keeps it private, and through competition for your business keeps quality in the plan.
